### 2. Vote to approve meeting minutes from last Equestrian Commission Meeting on 8/1/14

Patti Fahey made a motion to approve the minutes from 8/1/14 as they are written. Stephanie Cecola seconded that motion. All voted in favor. Motion was passed.

### 3. Introduction of New Members to the Equestrian Commission

Chairman Jane Clement gave each commissioner an opportunity to introduce themselves and state how long they'd lived in Barrington Hills and what their involvement has been in equestrian pursuits. New Commissioners include Jessica Underwood, Kelcey Roberts, and Stephanie Cecola.

#### b. Discussion of Equestrian Easement Map

1. Chairman Clement led a discussion about existing village equestrian easements and how they connect with the riding trails of the Riding Club of Barrington Hills. See Easement Map attached to tonight's meeting materials.

The idea was raised to consider asking the RCBH Vice President of Trails to attend our EC meetings so that we can stay better informed about how the village easements interconnect with the RCBH trail systems, especially as properties change ownership.

2. Jessica Underwood expressed an interest in gaining more information regarding what is planned and currently in progress at Horizon Farms now that it is owned by the FPDCC (Forest Preserve District of Cook County). Michelle Mason, our new Trustee Liaison introduced herself to the commissioners and stated that she will be also be the designated liaison of the village to the forest preserve. She will report back to us at our next meeting what she has learned about Horizon so we can stay current. Mason also announced that the village meeting regarding the Drury lawsuit against the Village of Barrington Hills has been rescheduled to Sept. 23rd at 6:30 at Countryside School.

3. Stephanie Cecola stated that she will be helping coordinate a possible police officer training put on by HARPS in October of this year. Dates are not yet determined. Cecola also noted that she would like to see the Village have an emergency phone tree in place in

case of horse emergencies. Patti Fahey stated that the RCBH had worked on this project in past years. Jessica Underwood will get information from the RCBH about where that project lies currently and report back to us at our December 2015 meeting

4. Anna Paul, Village of Barrington Hills Clerk, announced that there are a group of residents forming that are interested in developing materials that better promote Barrington Hills as a whole and they would like us to consider how the equestrian history and importance to the village will be presented in those materials. More information to follow.
5. Chairman Clement stated that currently we are scheduled to meet once per quarter as the Equestrian Commission, but if there was a need for a special meeting it could be arranged within the parameters of village requirements regarding timing of public notice and posting of an agenda.

# EQUESTRIAN COMMISSION

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## RULES PERTAINING TO PUBLIC COMMENT



Any person has the right to speak to an item on the agenda after the Public Meeting is opened and confirmation of the public notice is entered into the hearing record but before action is taken. Time is scheduled on the agenda to allow the public to provide input as testimony to the Equestrian Commission on a particular subject that is the purpose of the Public Meeting or of interest to the Equestrian Commission.

This is not a dialogue.

The Commission will consider all testimony after the conclusion of a presentation.

### PROCEDURE FOR PARTICIPATION

- 1) Sign up on the sheets provided.
- 2) When recognized, please proceed to podium.
- 3) State your name.
- 4) Please limit your comments to THREE MINUTES.

You may submit your written comments to the Village Clerk.

Comments of a personal nature directed towards individual Commission members, employees of the Village or any other individual are not permitted. It is the prerogative of the Presiding Officer of the Commission to limit the discussion of any speaker to allow for broad and diverse public participation. Speakers may submit materials, written testimony, or pictures to the Village Clerk for the consideration of the Commission.
