**VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS
PLAN COMMISSION MEETING
January 11, 2010**

The regular meeting of the Village of Barrington Hills Plan Commission was called to order at 7:30 p.m. by Chairman Stieper.

PREVIOUS MINUTES: Commissioner Hennelly made the motion, seconded by Commissioner O'Donnell to approve the September 14th Minutes. Motion carried unanimously by voice vote.

BACOG GROUNDWATER: Robert Kosin advised the Commission of the research under way by the Barrington Council of Governments regarding the documentation of groundwater in the general Barrington area. A presentation on that research was previously made to the Board of Trustees who in turn directed the Plan Commission to schedule such with BACOG.

Kurt Thomsen, a geologist made the presentation on behalf of BACOG. He reviewed the science of groundwater providing a definition of aquifer, aquitard and aquiclude. Illustrations were shown of the geological location of such features in the study area and the purported role in the availability of groundwater.

The Commission had received the regional study of groundwater by CMAP and inclusive of Mr. Thomsen discussed groundwater mining, usage scenarios and policy consideration. It was noted that Barrington Hills adjoins high yield municipal wells and its residents are dependent on shallow private wells that can be in conflict with such

usage patterns. The subject is an element of the Comprehensive Plan and will continued to be and action item of BACOG.

No further action was taken on this matter.
