

**ORDINANCE REPEALING AND REPLACING
SECTION 1-6-6(D) OF THE VILLAGE CODE**

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills, Illinois, a home-rule municipality (the "Village") has determined that Title 1, Chapter 6 of the Village Code requires certain amendments to the provisions thereof;

WHEREAS, in order to promote the health, safety, morals and general welfare of the Village and to protect the public health and safety of the citizens residing in the Village, the President and the Board of Trustees of the Village find and believe it to be in the best interest of the Village to repeal Section 1-6-6(D) of the Village Code and replace said Section as provided in this Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Village Board hereby finds that the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Special Counsel. Current Section 1-6-6(D) of the Village Code, shall be, and the same hereby is repealed and deleted in its entirety, and shall be and the same hereby is replaced with the following new Section 1-6-6(D):

Special Counsel; Appointment, Compensation, Duties:

1. **Appointment:** Legal counsel in addition to Village Attorney may be appointed by the Board of Trustees.
2. **Compensation:** The compensation of special counsel shall be fixed by the Board of Trustees.
3. **Duties:** The duties of such special counsel may be for such purposes as the Board of Trustees deems necessary or appropriate.

Section 3. Validity. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of the Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 4. Superseder and Effective Date. All ordinances, resolutions, motions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
