Re: Northwest Municipal Conference

The Roads and Bridges Committee has on occasion reviewed projects that involve county and state roadways. Most recently it has reviewed the multi-year programming of Cook County DOT. Information on such roadways ultimately originates from a coordinating council of municipalities in Northwest Cook County, known as the Northwest Municipal Conference.

Apparently the collaboration with other jurisdiction on projects is the future practice of roadway programming as well as other multi-jurisdiction civil engineering elements, i.e., storm water; it is therefore prudent to become a member of the NWMC. It should be noted that the Villages of Barrington, Inverness and South Barrington are members of NWMC. And all have such multi-jurisdictional roadways within their municipal boundaries.

Membership dues would be of approximately \$5,200 per year which is the lowest fee commensurate with the population of Barrington Hills.

The issue of membership may be presented to the Board of Trustees at its September meeting.
