A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES BY THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village") is a home-rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such is authorized to take all reasonable action pertaining to its affairs in accordance therewith; and

WHEREAS, the Village Police Department is in need of two new police utility vehicles to adequately perform the duties and obligations of the Village Police Department and to serve and protect the citizens of the Village; and

WHEREAS, it is the recommendation of the Village Police Department that the Village President and Board of Trustees authorize the purchase of two new Ford Interceptor Police Utility Vehicles at a combined expense not to exceed \$64,500.00; and

WHEREAS, based on the recommendation of the Village Police Department, the President and Board of Trustees has determined the purchase of two new Ford Interceptor Police Utility Vehicles, at a combined expense not to exceed \$64,500.00, is in the best interests of the Citizens of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, as a Home Rule municipality located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry, Illinois, the following:

SECTION ONE: The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION TWO: The Chief of Police is authorized to purchase two new Ford Interceptor Police Utility Vehicles at a combined expense not to exceed \$64,500.00, to be taken from the Village General Fund.

SECTION THREE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
