98 ALGONQUIN

Barrington United Methodist Church plans to prepare meals for the community. Health inspection was conducted by Cook County on behalf of Village of Barrington Hills (VBH) . VBH Code Officer was in attendance. **No violation found.**

5 POTTER LANE

Complaint 9-11-17: Trucks of fill being dumped every 20 minutes and excessive noise by banging tailgates. Dan Strahan (Gewalt Hamilton) did an onsite inspection and issued a stop work order.

UPDATE: Stop Work Order has been lifted for interior remodel (Building Permit P549). Stop Work Order for Site Development still in force. Site Development and Tree Preservation Permit Applications have been received. The Site Development Plan and Tree Preservation Plan have been approved by Gewalt Hamilton and Urban Forest Management, respectively. VBH is awaiting the signed Tree Preservation/Escrow Agreement with corresponding cashier's check.

340 OLD SUTTON

Complaint 7-5-17: Dumping of fill without permit. Dan Strahan visited property and witnessed dumping of fill material still in progress. Village engineer informed the bobcat operator that he needed a permit. Code officer spoke with owner to obtain permit prior to performing additional work. Site visit Monday, August 28th. A locked gate prevented an onsite inspection so code officer observed from street. Letter to be sent to homeowner that a permit is needed.

UPDATE: Building officer visited site 10-18-17 but could not access entire site due to the locked gate. Graded dirt was observed on the side of the driveway. Photos taken. An email was sent to owner and copied to village engineer.

231 BUTTERNUT

Complaint 6-26-17: Demo of barn incomplete; permit expired September, 2014

UPDATE: Building Officer met with homeowner to discuss erosion control and last items completed (installation of silt fence on pond site and application of seed and straw mat on graded earth) Photos taken. Demo of structure now conforms to village code requirements. **Closed.**
