SUMMARY
July 2008

TRAINING:

One Sergeant and one Officer attended Field Sobriety Testing training
The Accreditation Manager attended the CALEA Conference
One Lieutenant, the Communications Supervisor and three Police Assistants attended OnStar Public Safety training

D.U.I. ARRESTS:

Department personnel made (1) D.U.I. arrest in July. This compares to 10 for the same period last year.

HOUSEWATCH:

Department personnel conducted 686 house checks in July.

ALARMS:

During the reporting period, Department personnel responded to 60 Burglar Alarms, 4 Trouble Alarms, 11 Fire Alarms and 4 Panic/Hold-up alarm [79 total].

OTHER:

855 Wireless and 68 Wire line 9-1-1 calls were received.

The traffic unit issued 249 citations including 5 Suspended/Revoked/No Valid DL, 32 No Insurance, and 138 Speeding citations.

Domestic Situation

- 08-7031 07-04-08 Officers responded to an Algonquin River Road address for a reported overdose. On arrival, officers spoke with several subjects. It was determined that there was a domestic situation that lead to the female subject taking an overdose of pills. In speaking with the female subject, she advised that she became angry over her husband's ex-girlfriends calling their home. The argument turned physical when her husband attempted to take her cell phone from her. The wife had bruises and bite marks. The husband stated that the marks were accidental. The husband was arrested for domestic battery. He was transported to McHenry County Jail to await bond court. The wife was transported to GSH for medical treatment. Both subjects were issued domestic violence handbooks. No further action at this time.
- 08-7067 07-06-08 Officers responded to a Lake Cook Road residence for a reported domestic battery that had just occurred. On arrival, officers spoke with the victim who stated that he attended a party at the residence the night before and due to being intoxicated, he slept on the couch. When his girlfriend arrived in the morning and saw him sleeping on the couch with a female, she became enraged and told him to leave the premises. When he was gathering his belongings, she slapped and punched him several times. She fled the scene when he told her he was calling the police. The officer was able to locate the offender a few hours later. Complaints were signed, and the female subject was arrested for domestic battery. She was processed and held for bond court. Domestic violence handbooks were issued to both parties. No further action taken.
- 08-7253 07-13-08 An officer responded to the area of Route 68 and Healy for a driving complaint. The officer located the vehicle parked along the side of the road. After further investigation, it was determined that the subjects were having a heated argument. The female subject stated she wanted out of the vehicle and the male subject would not let her out. The officer transported the female subject to her residence in Hoffman Estates, and the male subject left for his residence. Both parties were issued domestic violence handbooks.
- 08-7471 07-19-08 Officers responded to a reported domestic disturbance at a Dundee Road residence. The complainant stated that her boyfriend became enraged over a broken glass. When she attempted to leave the residence, he broke the window of her vehicle causing a laceration to her arm. The victim was treated by paramedics and refused transport. No complaints were signed. Both parties were issued domestic violence handbooks and agreed to stay separated for the night.

Damage to Property

- 08-7058 07-05-08 A Hawthorne Lane resident reported his mailbox was damaged. It appeared the mailbox was run over by a vehicle due to the debris at the scene, and the amount of damage. No one was seen in the area.
- 08-7655 07-26-08 There were several reports of damage to construction equipment in the Ridge Road and Peraino area. No one was seen in the area. The area was placed on an extra watch. No further action taken.
- 08-7711 07-28-08 An Algonquin Road resident reported that someone cut his barbed wire fence. The complainant stated that there were empty liquor bottles in the area, but he has not seen anyone. No further action taken at this time.

Theft

- 08-7074 07-07-08 A Mid Oaks Lane resident reported that someone had created some fictitious checks on his account and several thousand dollars had been taken. The victim stated that particular checking account was not used very often, so the theft was not immediately discovered. The victim stated that the first fictitious check appeared after he had made a purchase of jewelry for his wife and thought possibly an employee of the jeweler may be the offender.
- 08-7436 07-18-08 An officer responded to the industrial park off of Route 14 for a reported theft. The victim stated that he stores his construction augers at this location, when he arrived on this date all his bits were gone. The victim did not see anyone in the area and there are no surveillance cameras. No further action taken at this time.
- 08-7075 07-07-08 A contractor for a Lake View Lane residence reported that several sections of copper gutters were missing from the property. No one was seen in the area. The residence was placed on a construction watch for three months.
- 08-7573 07-23-08 A Plum Tree Road resident reported the theft of several items from her horse trailer. The resident did observe a smaller vehicle in the area, but was unable to give any description. The victim was advised to forward a list of items missing. As of this date, no list has been received.
- 08-7627 07-25-08 An Old Sutton Road resident reported the theft of her dry cleaning that had been delivered to her front porch. The complainant's daughter reported that there were two suspicious people in the area, but it is unknown if they took the items in question. No further action taken.
- 08-7716 07-28-08 An Autumn Trail resident reported that there were checks stolen from her mail and used with a forged signature. The incident is being investigated by the fraud department; the victim was advised to contact the agency where the checks were cashed and make a forgery report with them as well.

Criminal Trespass to Land

08-7393 07-17-08 An officer responded to check a vacant home on Otis Road. On arrival, the officer observed three subjects attempting to close the garage door. The officer spoke with the subjects who stated that they had just arrived at the home and were only walking around. They stated that they did not do any of the damage. All three subjects were issued citations for trespassing. The officer made contact with the homeowner and advised her that the home needed to be secured. The condition of the home and its disrepair were forwarded to the Village Building officer for follow-up. No further action taken.
