Damage to Property

- 11-7161 12-13-11 A Plum Tree Road resident reported damage to a fence. She stated that she believed the damage was done by the neighbor's landscape crew. In checking the damage, the officer observed that the damage was old and would only entail replacing a couple metal posts. The officer proceeded to the neighbor's to meet with the homeowner and the landscape company foreman. Both parties advised that the fence was in very poor condition prior to any work being done. The officer advised them to avoid any further issues, to stay clear of the fence. They both agreed. No further action taken.
- 11-7185 12-20-11 A Brinker Road church reported damage to light fixtures in their garden area. No one was seen in the area. The property was placed on an extra watch.
- 11-7191 12-2-11 A Northwest Highway business owner reported the front driver side window was broken out of a vehicle that was parked in her parking lot over night. No one was seen in the area. The business was place on an extra watch.
- 11-7203 12-26-11 An employee for a church on Hawthorne Road reported that his car window was broken out and the side view mirror was torn off. Nothing else on the property was disturbed. No one was seen in the area. The property was placed on an extra watch.

The home appeared to have been winterized, but several items were also missing from the home. He was not concerned over the missing items; he was more concerned about someone having entered the home unlawfully. The home was posted with the property manager information. An extra watch was placed on the home.

Domestic

11-7204 12-27-11 Officers responded to a Brinker Road residence for a reported verbal domestic between husband and wife. On arrival, both parties were spoken to separately. The wife stated that her husband became angry over her taking money out of the safe, without his knowledge, to use for Christmas gifts as well as some household expenses. The husband stated that he became upset because his wife had spent money on a Christmas gift for him after they had agreed to not exchange gifts. He advised that he is trying to keep finances in order and he was upset that she took money without his knowledge. Both parties were issued domestic violence handbooks. No further action taken.
