March 2014 Summary of Activity

Fraud

A resident reported that he was contacted via email by a couple stating they wanted to rent a property he had listed. They had also sent a check for payment. Some of the context of the email gave the complainant an uneasy feeling over the legitimacy of the deal and he contacted BHPD. Investigation revealed that the check sent to the complainant was issued from an account of identity theft. Due to there being no monetary loss, the officer advised the complainant to cease all contact with the offenders.

DUI / No DL / Suspended / Revoked DL

DUI – 1 citation; No Valid Driver's License – 4 citations; Driving while License Suspended / Revoked – 6 arrests; Suspended Registration – 1 citation; Flee / Attempt to Elude – 1 citation

Harassment by Telephone

A resident reported receiving harassing phone calls. The calls were coming from an out of state number. The officer contacted the caller and advised him to stop the calls. The officer also suggested to the complainant that they block the number making the calls. The residence was placed on an extra watch.

Domestics

Officers responded to two reported domestics. The parties agreed to stay separated for the night. All parties were given domestic violence handbooks. No further action taken.

Assist Other Agency

An Officer assisted Barrington PD with a vehicle lockout.

An Officer assisted South Barrington PD in lock-up. While assisting in processing the prisoner, the officer found a baggie of pills on the prisoner. The pills were turned over to SBPD for their evidence handling.

Algonquin PD requested assistance on a traffic stop with several uncooperative subjects. Two subjects were taken into custody and turned over to Algonquin PD.

Vehicle Lock Out

Officers assisted two subjects gain entry into their vehicles.

Alarms

Officers responded to one burglar alarm with an unsecured door. The premise was checked for signs of burglary and key-holder was notified.

Citizen Assist

An officer stood by at a residence while the complainant removed personal property.

Animal Incidents

Six dogs were picked up by BHPD and four were returned to their owners, the other two were turned over to Strays Halfway House for adoption.

Two injured animals were terminated and removed from roadway.

Child Safety Seat Inspection

An officer inspected one car seat to make sure it was properly installed.
