

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORGANIZATION OF CERTAIN BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

WHEREAS, the reasoned debate, deliberation and findings by the Boards and Commissions of the Village of Barrington Hills is necessary for the governance of the Village;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

Section 1: INCORPORATION OF PREAMBLE. The Village Board hereby finds that the recital contained in the preamble to this Ordinance is true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2: MEMBERSHIP; TERMS; ORGANIZATION. Title Two "Boards and Commissions" of the Village Code, shall be, and the same hereby is, amended by the inserting the following in the named chapter and section of said Title:

2-2-2: MEMBERSHIP; TERMS; ORGANIZATION:

Every Member who shall be present when a question is stated from the chair shall vote thereon, including the chairman unless excused by a majority of the commissioners present or unless such Member has recused himself.

2-4-1: CREATION AND MEMBERSHIP:

* * *

Every member of said Board who shall be present when a question is stated from the chair shall vote thereon, including the chair unless excused by a majority of the members present or unless such member has recused himself.

2-6-2: MEMBERSHIP; TERMS; ORGANIZATION:

* * *

Every member of said Board who shall be present when a question is stated from the chair shall vote thereon, including the chairman unless excused by a majority of the members present or unless such member has recused himself.

2-8-2: MEMBERSHIP; TERMS; ORGANIZATION:

* * *

Every Commissioner who shall be present when a question is stated from the chair shall vote thereon, including the chairman unless excused by a majority of the commissioners present or unless such member has recused himself.

Section 3: VALIDITY. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 4: SUPERSEDER AND EFFECTIVE DATE. All resolutions, motions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
