

**ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 8-1-3 OF THE VILLAGE CODE
REGARDING THE RANK STRUCTURE OF THE VILLAGE POLICE DEPARTMENT**

WHEREAS Village Barrington Hills, Illinois (the “Village”) pursuant to Section 8-1-1 has created a police department for the Village consisting of a chief of police and such other members as may be authorized by resolution of the board of trustees;

WHEREAS, The President and the Board of Trustees of the Village find and believe it to be in the best interest of the Village that Section 8-1-3 of the Village Code be amended to add, within the ranks of the police department for the Village, the new position of “Deputy Chief.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, Illinois, as a home rule municipality, the following:

Section 1. Incorporation of Preambles. The Village Board hereby finds that the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and does incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Rank Structure. Section 8-1-3 of the Village Code, shall be, and the same hereby is, deleted in its entirety and the following is inserted in lieu thereof:

“In addition to the office of chief of police, there shall exist within the department the ranks of patrolman, sergeant, lieutenant and deputy chief. The number of members at each rank, the salary level for each rank, the promotion of members from one rank to another, and all other matters so relating shall be determined as provided by related ordinances of the village and any specific rules or regulations established by the village board of trustees not in conflict therewith.”

Section 3. Validity. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section 4. Superseder and Effective Date. All resolutions, motions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith, are to the extent of such conflict hereby superseded; and this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
