ROADS AND BRIDGES MONTHLY REPORT
MARCH 2012

2012 ROAD CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM

The preliminary engineering and preconstruction is being completed prior to spring and the receipt of bids.

Algonquin Township has agreed to contribute the township's portion of 2013 work on Spring Creek Road at typical Township costs.

Huddleston McBride survey results revealed one buried culvert on Braeburn Road which will be excavated prior to the resurfacing.

2012 DRAINAGE PROGRAM

Dan Strahan will provide a bid recommendation based on bids received Wednesday, March 21st.

CUBA ROAD BRIDGE

Geometric Design Options have been discussed preparatory to the grant request and a decision was made to proceed with a fully engineered and precast modular component system. The precast arch system, complete with wing walls and headwalls offers the advantages of fast installation, extensive technical support and meets all engineering specifications.

In addition, this type of installation offers increased width on the bridge deck and no elevation increase, as well as less maintenance and inspections due to its construction, thus providing the village with a more cost effective, maintenance free structure going forward

Right of way and parcel history is being processed.

A meeting with Tom Gooch, Cuba Township Highway supervisor will be scheduled to discuss straightening the portion of Cuba Road east of Buckley, where it exits the village boundaries, to improve the sightline as one exits West Cuba Road from the north.

PRIVATE ROAD HOMEOWNERS MEETING FOLLOWUP

Development of a new web page for private road homeowners has been started and will include materials for homeowners associations in Lake County.

DUNDEE LANE

There have been two separate requests from residents regarding speeding on Dundee Lane by cut through traffic and the accidents at Dundee Lane and Rt. 59. Requests for special signage, a change in the speed limit to 35 mph on Rt. 59 from Rt. 68 to Barrington Road and a request for a new stop sign at Sarah and Dundee Lanes have and are being addressed. The mobile speed sign will be placed on Dundee Lane as soon as all danger of snow has passed.

RT. 62

IDOT advises that construction will begin on April 20 on Rt. 62 from Penny Road to just south of Palatine Road for additional lanes and retaining walls.

Projected completion date is October 31, 2012.
