

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ("MOU") is made and entered into as of this _____ day of _____, 2012, by and between the Village of Barrington Hills, an Illinois home-rule municipality (the "Village") and QuadCom 911, an intergovernmental agency ("QuadCom"), (the Village and QuadCom are collectively referred to herein as, the "Parties").

RECITALS

A. WHEREAS, QuadCom proposes to install and maintain police and fire VHF High Band repeater antennae on the support structure ("Tower") and lease or sublease space for two or more receivers in the Village's portion of the equipment shed ("Blockhouse"), both located on Village Hall property at 112 Algonquin Road, Barrington Hills, Illinois ("Village Hall");

B. WHEREAS, Pursuant to a prior oral agreement between QuadCom and the Village, QuadCom currently operates a UHF police antenna on the Tower and a receiver in the Blockhouse for dispatching services for the South Barrington Police Department;

C. WHEREAS, deployment of the Fire Department VHF High Band repeater antennae on the Tower and activation of the receiver in the Blockhouse is essential to the operation of the QuadCom's 9-1-1 system to dispatch public safety agencies within QuadCom's network;

D. WHEREAS, QuadCom, pursuant to a study performed by Chicago Communications, has determined that locating the repeater antennae on the Tower will alleviate the immediate problem of sub-optimal service in the far east end of the East Dundee and Countryside Fire Protection District;

E. WHEREAS, QuadCom and the Village contemplate entering into a license agreement and sublease for installation and operation of the repeater antennae and receivers;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree as follows:

1. The Parties agree to cooperate with each other to reach a mutually agreeable license for use of the Tower by QuadCom to install police and fire repeater antennae and a mutually agreeable sublease for use of the Blockhouse to install the receivers that complement the repeater antennae for use with QuadCom's 9-1-1 dispatching system.

2. Within thirty (30) days of full execution of this Memorandum of Understanding, the Village shall deliver to QuadCom, the license agreement and sublease as discussed aforesaid, and QuadCom shall execute same in a timely

manner. There shall be no consideration paid by QuadCom under the license agreement or the sublease. The term of the license agreement and corresponding sublease shall be ten (10) years with five (5) year automatic renewal terms, provided, however, either Party may terminate the license agreement and/or corresponding sublease upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other Party.
