

RESOLUTION 13-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BARRINGTON HONOR RIDE AND RUN IN THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village"), it is for the best interests of the Village to allow the Barrington Honor Ride and Run ("Honor Run") to use Village roads over the Route described on Exhibit A ("Route") beginning at 8:30 a.m. and ending at 10:00 a.m. on October 6, 2013 ("Event") with no more than 250 Riders.

WHEREAS, the Honor Run, sponsored by USA Cycling Event Permit Number 2013-2926 issued by USA Cycling and will require the partial or complete closing of the Village roads located on the Route; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 121, Paragraph 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/4-408), the Village is required to lawfully assume all responsibility and liability involved in the closing of any portion of a public highway within its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake, and McHenry in the State of Illinois, a home rule municipality as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Responsibility and Liability. The President and Board of Trustees agree that the Village will assume, to the extent required pursuant to of the Illinois Highway Code, full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of traffic during the time the Honor Run is in effect, and all liabilities for damages of any kind occasioned by the closing of the Route for the Honor Run.

Section 3: Insurance. USA Cycling shall provide to the Village evidence of liability insurance in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 naming the Village as an additional insured prior to the date of the Honor Run.

Section 4. Detours. The President and Board of Trustees further agree that efficient, all weather detours will be maintained conspicuously marked and judiciously police patrolled for the benefit of automobile traffic deviated from the Route. The requirement of single file bicycle riding shall be waived for the Event.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.



Who Is An Insured

*State Or Political
Subdivision – Permits*

Any state or political subdivision designated below is an **insured**; but they are **insureds** only with respect to liability arising out of operations performed by you or on your behalf for which the state or political subdivision has issued a permit.

(605 ILCS 5/4-408) (from Ch. 121, par. 4-408)

Sec. 4-408. The Department may, upon application by the proper authorities of any local governmental agency, issue a permit to such agency to temporarily close to traffic any portion of a State highway for any public purpose or for any temporary needs of such agency. Such permit shall be issued only upon the explicit agreement of the local governmental agency to assume all liabilities and pay all claims for any damages which shall be occasioned by such closing and such agreement shall be made a part of every such permit. When a State highway is closed by a local governmental agency under the terms of a permit, the agency shall maintain efficient detours satisfactory to the Department around the portion of the closed highway. Such detour shall be plainly and conspicuously marked with signs by which traffic may be guided around that part of the State highway so closed.
