The Illinois Bike Transportation Plan is rapidly pedaling toward the finish line but it still needs your input. The Illinois Department of Transportation has identified "connectivity" as a guiding theme in the development of this first statewide bicycle plan. Now the department has produced an interactive, online tool that will allow users to suggest new regional bicycle connections, identify current barriers to bicycling in Illinois, and provide general input to planning team.
