

RESOLUTION 14-

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BARRINGTON HONOR RIDE AND RUN IN THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village"), it is for the best interests of the Village to allow the Barrington Honor Ride and Run ("Honor Run") to use Village roads over the Route described on Exhibit A ("Route") beginning at 7:30 a.m. and ending at 10:30 a.m. on August 17, 2014 ("Event") with no more than 250 Riders.

WHEREAS, the Honor Run, sponsored by USA Cycling Inc. Event Permit Number 2014-1492 issued by USA Cycling and will require the partial or complete closing of the Village roads located on the Route; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 121, Paragraph 4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/4-408), the Village is required to lawfully assume all responsibility and liability involved in the closing of any portion of a public highway within its jurisdiction.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake, and McHenry in the State of Illinois, a home rule municipality as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Responsibility and Liability. The President and Board of Trustees agree that the Village will assume, to the extent required pursuant to of the Illinois Highway Code, full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of traffic during the time the Honor Run is in effect, and all liabilities for damages of any kind occasioned by the closing of the Route for the Honor Run.

Section 3: Insurance. USA Cycling Inc. shall provide to the Village evidence of liability insurance in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 naming the Village as an additional insured prior to the date of the Honor Run.

Section 4. Detours. The President and Board of Trustees further agree that efficient, all weather detours will be maintained conspicuously marked and judiciously police patrolled for the benefit of automobile traffic deviated from the Route. The requirement of single file bicycle riding shall be waived for the Event.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.

Dear President McLaughlin and Village of Barrington Hills Trustees:

This letter is written to introduce the 4th annual Barrington Honor Ride & Run (“BHRR”) and request use of Barrington Hills’ roads for the event. This year’s BHRR will be held at Citizen’s Park on August 17th, and will have 3 bike ride routes (45, 30, and 20 mile distances). The anticipated routes for the bike ride will take place on paved streets through Barrington, Lake Barrington, and Barrington Hills. Only the 45 mile route would utilize Barrington Hills’ roads. BHRR has already received approval for the use of the roads in Barrington and Lake Barrington.

Initially BHRR did not intend to have as many miles as we are now requesting in Barrington Hills due to the challenge posed to participants on our beautiful, but steep, hills. However, we ran into a snag with the original route planned for the Honor Ride due to the construction closure of Roberts Road. As such, the longer route would need to be in Barrington Hills for more miles than originally anticipated. We have presented two route options to Chief Murphy and Deputy Chief Semelsberger who, in turn, presented the options to Trustee Gohl. The preferred route they have chosen comes into Barrington Hills from South Bound Kelsey Rd, left onto Cuba, left onto Merri Oaks / Cuba, right onto Buckley, right onto Oak Knoll, right onto Ridge, left onto Spring Creek, right onto Haegers Bend, right onto Chapel Rd., left onto Church Rd., right onto Algonquin, right onto Braeburn Rd., right onto Spring Creek, right onto Haegers Bend, right onto Chapel Rd., left onto Church Rd., right onto Algonquin Rd., right onto Plum Tree Rd. and back out onto Kelsey North Bound. We have included a map of the Barrington Hills portion of the route as well a Certificate of Insurance, flyers and photos. A link to the full map can be found at

Proceeds from BHRR benefit Ride 2 Recovery (R2R). R2R is produced to benefit mental and physical rehabilitation programs for our country’s wounded and healing veterans that features cycling as the core activity. R2R raises money to support cycling programs at military and VA locations around the U.S. to help healing heroes

overcome obstacles they face. They have found through their efforts that cycling is an important part of the recovery process because it's an activity that everyone can do, no matter the disability and cycling helps speed up the recovery process. R2R has several programs including Challenges and Honor Rides.

Challenges are multi-day events that cover 350-450 miles. A Challenge will push the participant to their limit, both physically and mentally. This program is the one most attended by the injured veterans and healing heroes. It gives them a chance to interact with others in an activity that they participated in prior to their injury. It also provides the psychological benefit of surmounting a challenge and the camaraderie of meeting a challenge with like-minded friends, where one's disability is not the focus.

Honor Rides, such as BHRR, are one-day events that are held around the country to help raise money and promote awareness for R2R's programs. The BHRR is a 100% charitable event and we have been able to raise the most dollars for any Honor Ride the last 2 years in part due to the "In Kind" donations from sponsors and the Villages and Police Departments that have waived their fee's and donated their time.

BHRR will also have a 5k and 10k run that will take place in Cuba Marsh, along with an obstacle course for children. New this year, we have teamed with Bike Barrington and Safety Town. They will be putting on a free children's ride through Citizen's Park that will have some nice incentives, like bike helmets and bike safety inspections. For the "After Party" we will have entertainment including Underwater People and Darryl Markette, a BBQ, beer, and the ability to share in some stories on what R2R's mission is and what riding a bike and being part of a team means for the wounded veterans served by R2R.


