In response to the public comment section of the minutes attributed to me - I would like to make the following corrections and clarifications.

- my understanding from the April 30, 2014 BOT meeting is that both documents provided at the 2/24/2014 meeting will be added to the minutes.
- these documents include a letter from Atty. Doug Wamback and one report from the village engineer from his inspection of 335 Ridge Road. All trustees were provided copies of these documents prior to the February meeting and within the perimeters of the rules for public comment. I have attached copies for your convenience.

- I am attributed with saying 'that concerns about my property have finally been addressed last year with the installation of President McLaughlin'. May I state nothing could be further from the truth - nothing has been done. 335 Ridge Road continues to contaminate and will continue to contaminate my property until the septic is moved, the storm water overflow from that address and St. Marks Church is re routed, and the pond backup is corrected.

My purpose in attending this meeting was to ask why these issues are not addressed. Some may be pending but enforcement is not forthcoming as it is with other residents. And lastly why is it the village refuses to enforce their very own ordinances? Especially when they pertain to contamination. More directly the enforcement of septic and flooding as well as contamination and stormwater overflow as it pertains to a commercial property. Even according to the village - St. Mark's Church and school are considered a commercial property - this includes by definition of the state of Illinois as well.

At the February meeting there was discussion among the trustees regarding the annexation of 60 Spring Creek Road. The direction and location of the property in question was intentionally misleading by Trustee Gohl. Conveniently the audio recording was deleted. Please verify and correct in writing the exact address, location and whether this property was de-annexed or annexed to Barrington Hills. Please cite public meeting/hearings and adherence to all applicable committees etc regarding this address

Lastly, whoever is transcribing the minutes needs to be removed from her position. Changing or deleting correct verbiage to get it into the public record is unconscionable. It is my tax monies that pay her salary and health insurance and the clerk should be held to task regarding her intentional misconduct. Please be advised - once again - of my racial minority status. I find it odd that I alone am being singled out and treated differently than other residents. The recent remarks at the April meeting of Dan Grecco are a bit too late.

Thank you for your time and I look forward to a reply regarding the lack of enforcement and the other issues I asked to be addressed.

(Example - it took over 6 years for the Strahan to acknowledge that the septic at 335 Ridge was located in a wetland and situated in a harmful location violating numerous village ordinances). I thereby state to you that I will not work nor do I wish Strahan involved in the Oak Lake Drainage project. Especially any communication or construction with my property. He has proven himself incompetent. Gewalt is a large company and I am quite sure a more reliable and honest engineer can easily be substituted at no cost to this village. There is a police report stating that Strahan is not to trespass again onto my property - this from last year.
