

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PERMITTING REQUIREMENTS  
FOR COMPETITIVE RACES OR EVENTS IN THE VILLAGE  
SET FORTH IN TITLE 9, CHAPTER 7 OF THE VILLAGE CODE**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of Barrington Hills (“Village”) is a home-rule municipality pursuant to Article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such, is authorized to take all reasonable action pertaining to its affairs in accordance therewith; and

**WHEREAS**, in 2014, the Village established permitting requirements for competitive races or events that take place in the Village; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village Board has determined that it is in the best interest of the Village to amend certain permitting requirements concerning the limit on persons attending a competitive race or event and the time period allowed for the same, and to further provide for the review and approval of permit applications by the Village Chief of Police, so as to ensure the health and safety of the citizens of the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, a home-rule municipality, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry, Illinois, as follows:

**SECTION ONE:** The recitals set forth above are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

**SECTION TWO:** Title 9, Chapter 7, Section 9-7-4(B) of the Village Code shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

(B) Contents: The application for a competitive race or event permit shall set forth the following information:

1. The name, address and phone number of person seeking to conduct such a race or event.
2. If the race or event is proposed to be conducted for, on behalf of, or by an organization, the name, address and phone number of the headquarters of the organization, and of the authorized and responsible persons of such organization.
3. The name, address and phone number of the person who will be the race or event chairman or who will be responsible for its conduct.
4. The date when the race or event is to be conducted.
5. The route it will be traveled, the starting point and finishing point entering the village.
6. The number of persons.
7. The hours when such a race or event shall start and finish within the village limits; after that time persons shall be recovered from the route.

8. The competitive race or event organizers shall provide to the village evidence of liability insurance in the amount of five million dollars (\$5,000,000.00) naming the village as an additional insured prior to the date of the race or event.

**SECTION THREE:** Title 9, Chapter 7, Section 9-7-5 of the Village Code shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

Within five (5) business days of receiving an application or within such extended time period as may be necessary, the chief of Police shall advise the Village Clerk to issue a permit if a determination is made that:

- (A) The conduct of the race or event will not substantially interrupt the safe and orderly movement of other concurrent traffic to its route.
- (B) The conduct of the race or event will not require the diversion of so great a number of police officers of the village to properly prevent normal police protection to the village.
- (C) The conduct of such race or event will not interfere with the movement of emergency vehicles.
- (D) The conduct of such race or event is not reasonably likely to cause injury to person or property, to provoke disorderly conduct or create a disturbance.
- (E) The race or event is scheduled to move from its point of entry and exit of the village expeditiously and without unreasonable delays en route.
- (F) Any other factors or conditions determined to be in the best interests of the health and safety of village citizens as determined by the village chief of police.

**SECTION FOUR:** This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication in pamphlet form in the manner provided by law.


