## A RESOLUTION AFFIRMING TRAFFIC PLANING FOR GRADE SEPARATION BY THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON

WHEREAS, the Barrington area is within a Chicago regional intersection of state routes, county highways and rail road tracks; and

WHEREAS, the free flow of traffic including not only for commerce and travel but, the passage of goods and services and most importantly, the delivery of public safety; and

WHEREAS, the absence of grade separation between pedestrian, vehicle, and railroad in this network especially in the Village of Barrington impairs function and jeopardizes safety; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills is part of that same network inclusive of those state routes and rail lines to wit failure in Barrington impairs that flow through Barrington Hills

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, located in the counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry in the state of Illinois as a home rule municipality the following:

Section One. The forgoing statement is found to be a true and accurate recitation of the matter and interest of the Village of Barrington Hills.

**Section Two**. The Village of Barrington Hills when so needed will support a program to establish a grade separation of traffic in manner and form to best provide for the free flow through the Village of Barrington.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the resolution shall be enrolled in the minutes of the meeting as a public record upon its passage and approval as provided by law.
