RESOLUTION 11-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE BARRINGTON HONOR RIDE AND RUN IN THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the corporate authorities of the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village"), it is for the best interests of the Village to hold the Barrington Honor Ride and Run ("Honor Run") on a route agreed to Honor Run and the Village (the "Route"), beginning at 12:20 p.m. and ending at 2:00 p.m. on October 23, 2011; and

WHEREAS, the Honor Run will require the partial or complete closing of the streets located on the Route; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5/4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code (605 ILCS 5/4-408), the Village is required to lawfully assume all responsibility and liability involved in the closing of any portion of a public highway.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake, and McHenry in the State of Illinois, a home rule municipality as follows:

Section 1. Recitals. The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated into this Resolution as findings of the President and Board of Trustees.

Section 2. Responsibility and Liability. The President and Board of Trustees agree that the Village will assume, to the extent required pursuant to section 5/4-408 of the Illinois Highway Code, full responsibility for the direction, protection and regulation of traffic during the time the detour is in effect, and all liabilities for damages of any kind occasioned by the closing of said Route.

Section 3: Insurance. Honor Ride shall provide liability insurance in the amount of \$5,000,000.00 prior to the date of the event.

Section 4. Detours. The President and Board of Trustees further agree that efficient, all weather detours will be maintained conspicuously marked and judiciously police patrolled for the benefit of traffic deviated from the, Route. The requirement that riders ride single file during the event shall be waived for the event.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
