RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2014 EDITION OF THE OFFICIAL ZONING MAP OF THE VILLAGE OF BARRINGTON HILLS

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village") located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry in the State of Illinois, is a home rule municipality; and

WHEREAS, Section 5/11-13-19 the Illinois Municipal Code, requires the Village authorities to publish annually, a map clearly showing the existing zoning uses, divisions, restrictions, regulations and classifications of the Village for the preceding calendar year; and

WHEREAS, Section 5/11-13-19 of the Illinois Municipal Code also authorizes the Village to establish a fee to be charged any person desiring a copy of such map; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 5-4-2 of the Village Code, the Village Engineer has updated the Official Zoning Map of the Village for calendar year 2014 (the "2014 Official Zoning Map") showing the location and boundaries of the zoning districts established by section 5-4-1 of the Village Code; and

WHEREAS, the Zoning Board of Appeals for the Village (the "ZBA") held a public hearing on Monday, March 17, 2014 to review the 2014 Official Zoning Map and has determined that the 2014 Official Zoning Map accurately and legibly portrays the location and boundaries of the zoning districts in the Village as of January 1, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, located in the Counties of Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry in the State of Illinois, a home rule municipality, the following:

<u>Section One</u>: The Official Zoning Map for the Village of Barrington Hills is hereby adopted and published in the form attached to this Resolution with the year of adoption inscribed on the map below the title of the map.

<u>Section Two</u>: Copies of the Official Zoning Map shall be made available at the Village Hall to any interested person for a fee of \$10.00 to cover the cost of publication.

<u>Section Three</u>: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval and publication according to law.
