

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE OVERWEIGHT PERMIT
REQUIREMENTS DURING PERIOD OF TEMPORARY WEIGHT LIMITS**

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (the "Village") limits the weight of vehicles on its roads during certain times of the year; and

WHEREAS, the Village is desirous of permitting the continual access to those roads so as to avoid the disruption or suspension of time dependent projects which rely on the uninterrupted access of those vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, Cook, Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties, State of Illinois, as a Home Rule municipality the following:

Section One. Section 9-2-6-3(B) shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"...vehicles traveling pursuant to seasonal permits issued during the period of a temporary weight limit."

Section Two. Section 9-2-6-4(E) shall be and hereby is amended and the following (4) is numerically inserted thereof so as to be and read as follows:

Any vehicle requiring a permit during the period of a temporary weight limit (Section 9-2-6-3) shall rebate to the Village a fee of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per load regardless if it obtained a permit prior to the imposition of the temporary limit.

Section Three. Should any part or provision of this Ordinance be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the same shall not affect the validity of this Ordinance as a whole or any part thereof, other than the part declared to be invalid.

Section Four. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication according to law.
