## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE VILLAGE'S OVERWEIGHT VEHICLE REGULATIONS IN SECTION 9-2-6-2 OF THE VILLAGE CODE

WHEREAS, the Village of Barrington Hills (hereinafter the "Village") is a duly organized and existing Illinois home rule municipality; and

WHEREAS, the Village has previously enacted overweight vehicle regulations in connection with the use of roads within the jurisdiction of the Village, which regulations are set forth in Chapter 2 of the Village Code; and

WHEREAS, currently, the Village provides for a number of exempt vehicles to the Village's overweight vehicle regulations including but not limited to vehicles required for residential repair of septic systems or water wells and vehicles operated by home heating supply companies; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined that moving vehicles, used to transport residential personal property, should also be exempt from the Village's overweight vehicle regulations so as to reduce the costs associated with residential moving activity in the Village; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills, a home rule community located in Cook, Lake, Kane and McHenry Counties, Illinois, duly assembled at a regular meeting, as follows:

**SECTION ONE**: That the forgoing recitals are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**SECTION TWO**: That Title 9, Chapter 2, Section 9-2-6-2 (C) shall be amended to add the underscored language as follows:

Said weight limitations shall not apply to: agricultural implements; vehicles with loads of livestock (including horses), hay, straw, corn, grain, fodder, fertilizer or other similar farm products or farm byproducts used in the direct production of agriculture; vehicles (including loads) required for emergency repair of public utility facilities or properties; vehicles (including loads) required for repair of septic systems or water wells; vehicles (including loads) operated by home heating supply companies; moving vans or trucks (including loads) used for delivering or picking up residential personal property on streets within the jurisdiction of the Village; firefighting equipment; vehicles (including loads) or equipment used for snow and ice removal under contract with the Village; vehicles (including loads) used in the transport or disposal of garbage, refuse or septage; or vehicles (including loads) operating under an overweight permit as provided in this Chapter.

**SECTION THREE**: That all other ordinances and resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance, are, to the extent of such conflict, expressly repealed.

**SECTION FOUR:** That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
