COMMERATIVE PROCLAMATION FOR THE 50TH YEAR ANNIVERSARY

WHEREAS, there was created on July 5, 1957 a general purpose unit of local government named the Village of Barrington Hills ("Village"); and

WHEREAS, the residents of the Village took for themselves the name of the Township of Barrington, a unit government whose founding occurred some 125 years previously; and

WHEREAS, this historical lineage had and would see residents come to the aid of their community, state and country; and

WHEREAS, it is only fitting then on the fiftieth anniversary of this Village to recognize the sacrifice of its constituents in a historical reenactment of an encampment of the 8th Illinois Cavalry of which some 200 served in the great Civil War; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington Hills in Cook Kane, Lake and McHenry Counties Illinois as a home rule municipality the following:

ONE. The grounds of the Village Hall shall be the place of the commemoration on June 30, 2007 whereupon this Nation's flag has flown with out falter for some thirty three years.

TWO. Time shall be set aside in suitable ceremony to acknowledge the persons and their sacrifice in the times of the 8th Illinois Cavalry.

THREE. Time shall also be set aside that day in suitable celebration of a community spirit of 50 years since it was first acknowledge that now there is the Village of Barrington Hills.
